- **4.** During the deliberations EAC observed that P.P. submitted MOU with DFO for plantation of trees in the area, which is equivalent 33.3 per cent of the statutory requirement of the Green Belt. P.P. will ensure to plant type of trees, number of trees and the location of trees on the advice and approval of DFO. This will ensure the overall green belt statutory requirement of 33 per cent by the project proposal proponent.
- 5. The proposal was appraised by the Expert Appraisal Committee (Industry-2) in the Ministry in its meeting held on 28-30th September, 2021. The EAC, after detailed deliberations, recommended the amendment in EC as proposed by the project proponent. Based on recommendations of the EAC, the Ministry of Environment, Forest and Climate Change hereby accords approval to the proposed amendments in the environmental clearance dated 12th December, 2017 as stated in para 3 above, for the project Guru Gobind Singh Polymer Addition Project, District Bathinda, Punjab by M/s. HPCL-MITTAL ENERGY LIMITED (HMEL).
